CHECK-IN

Please check in before your first game as you enter the facility at admissions. Each team will be given 2 coaches' wristbands when teams check-in. No additional wristbands will be given.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- Work Duties: Teams are required to provide a work crew for their work assignment in pool play. PLEASE pay close attention to your reffing assignments. Teams need to provide for each court: 2 line judges, 1 scoreboard, 1 book 1 libero tracker, and 1 R2. **For bracket play, we ask an adult coach fill the R2 role for this event.**
- Teams need to bring their volleyballs and carts for warm-ups.
- Warm-Ups:
 - Warm-ups for rounds 1-7-7 will be 3-3-3
 - Warm-ups for the remainder of the tournament will be 3-3
- Play time will continue after each round finishes. This means that play can begin early and teams need to pay attention to what is going on their court.

PREP DIG WILL BE UTILIZING THE USAV TIEBREAKER PROCEDURES

1. Head To Head
2. MATCH % (Matches won divided by matches played);
3. Set % (Sets won divided by games played);
 - a. If there is a three-way tie, set % will determine the top finisher of those in the tie.
 - b. Of the teams remaining, the team that won head-to-head in that pool will be the next highest finisher in the pool
4. TOTAL POINT DIFFERENTIAL (Total # of points won subtracted from total # of points lost);
5. COIN FLIP
